SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND INFORMATION

- ◇ Applicants and/or their parent(s) must be a member(s) in generally good standing at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. Active membership includes regular attendance at worship, proportional giving, and participation in a ministry.
- ◇ Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a Lutheran school, having met the regular admission standards of said school.
- ◇ Upon acceptance by the school for the upcoming year, an application must be submitted to the Director of Business Administration by July 1. Application forms are available in the Office. Applicants from Lutheran South Academy must also complete the LSA Student Assistance Application as well. Both are submitted to the Gloria Dei church office.
- ◇ Applications are reviewed by the Lutheran Education Committee which is authorized by the Board of Directors. The total amount of the grants awarded will not exceed the amount available in the Lutheran Education Fund. The amount awarded to individual students will depend primarily on their meeting these qualifications.
- ◇ Scholarship and grant checks will be made payable to and mailed directly to the business office of the school. Please indicate on the application the address to which the funds are to be mailed.
- ◇ Applicants must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale at the school in which he or she is enrolled in order to qualify for further support.
- ◇ Assistance for the Early Childhood Ministry will be applied for through the Director of Early Childhood Ministries who will make recommendations to the Lutheran Education Committee.
- ◇ Applicants must apply to the Lutheran Education Committee each year to receive this assistance.
